Dear Parents/Carers,

Preparations have been under way this week to welcome back all of our families on Monday 8th March.

We are so excited to be opening our doors to you all once again. You have all worked incredibly hard whilst in lockdown and we have been really impressed at the work that you have all been doing, thank you to our children for keeping up the hard work and to our parents for all their support over the last few weeks, I'm sure that you will have loved every minute of your temporary teaching roles, but we are ready to take over once again.

Things in school will look very much like they did in September. The children will continue to be in their class bubbles during the day and we will continue with the staggered drop off and pick up times.

Staff have now been instructed to wear masks when outside of the classroom, this will include on the school gates at drop off and pick up times. We have also been instructed that if parents are stepping inside the school/nursery gates to drop their children off, that they must also please wear a face covering unless medically exempt.
